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### We strengthen communities

The Department of Commerce touches every aspect of community and economic development. We work with local governments, businesses and civic leaders to strengthen communities so all residents may thrive and prosper.



#### **CEF1 Grid Modernization Grants to Utilities**

- Grants to competitively selected consortium of utilities, utility vendors and researchers
- Consortium must match or exceed state investment
- Consortium projects will:
  - Integrate intermittent renewables through energy storage and information technology
  - Dispatch energy storage resources from utility control rooms
  - Use thermal properties of buildings and/or district energy systems to store energy
  - Improve the reliability and reduce the costs of intermittent or distributed energy
- Form Experts Panel to review and rank proposals

### **CEF1 Grid Modernization Projects**

SnoPUD MESA 2 2MW/6.4MW hr **\$4.4M**  4 projects with 3 utilities 7MW/15MWhr of BESS

Avista -Pullman BESS 1MW/3.2MW hr \$3.2M

Pacific Northwest National Laboratory Use Case Analysis

SnoPUD MESA 1 2MW/1MWhr **\$2.4M** 

\$14.3M Grant Funds




#### **CEF2 Grid Modernization Grants to Utilities**

- Similar to CEF1 target audience and emphasis on advancing new technology with addition of:
  - New Utility Advisory Group to advise on program framework
  - Increased emphasis on projects with resiliency benefits
  - Two stage process Conceptual/feedback & full application

### **CEF2 Grid Modernization Projects**




# What's next for the Clean Energy Fund?

### **Clean Energy Fund 3 - Competitive Programs**

 Matching Program for Energy Research and Development - \$8.6 million

- Grid Modernization Program \$11 million
- Transportation Electrification \$11 million
- Solar \$4 million

#### **CEF3 Grid Modernization Grants to Utilities**

Similar to CEF1 & CEF2 target audience, emphasis and application process. Focus areas:

- Advancement of clean and renewable energy technologies, and transmission and distribution control systems;
- Supporting integration of renewable energy sources, deployment of distributed energy resources and sustainable microgrids; and
- Increasing utility customer options for energy sources, energy efficiency, energy equipment and utility services.





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
